

April 6, 2009 Park Board meeting

In attendance: Cindy Kimm, Deana Wright, Tom Kurtz, Marggie Faley, Peg Garton

Meeting was called to order at 1:03PM by President, Cindy Kimm.

Minutes of March 16 meeting were approved as distributed.

Building and Grounds: Ground will be leveled this week at Riverside Gardens in preparation for landscaping around the Grand Gazebo. Graffiti is to be cleaned under the bridge at RSG.

Maintenance: Maintenance employees will work on repainting the pavilion where needed. They will proceed with the first phase of painting where the need is greatest. Maintenance Plan drawn up by the board was reviewed and work completed was noted. In the Park Survey volunteers indicated interest in helping with clean up and other volunteering in the parks. We appreciate volunteers stepping forward who will help with projects in the parks.

Maintenance will remove grass near flag pole to prepare the area for flag stone base. Graffiti at the L-C Park Pavilion will be removed. The police will follow up our report of this vandalism. The bulletin board at L-C Park pavilion will be utilized for advertising the weekday specials on rentals of the pavilion.

Grand Pavilion dedication plans for May 20th are ongoing. Marggie will spear head initial landscaping on April 25th

Resolutions: The Board reviewed the proposal for receiving bids. Copies were distributed to the Board for final review. Final passage of the resolution tabled until next meeting.

Contract for rental of the Grand pavilion at RSG will be available via office Web Page as well as the town office.

Deana is compiling the remainder of the Park Surveys. Requests continue from the community for bathrooms at RSG and more parking at L-C Park.

Design for the RSG proposed Restroom was reviewed including a ground well location and green spaces planned. The Board approved this design plan and it will go to the engineer. The Board will present its proposal to the Town Council to implement the Restroom design.

Tom reported on the work list for L-C Park grounds and Imagination Station area. He will experiment with a pad under paddle swings to eliminate a hole where mulch is removed. The area will be mulched on top of the pad.

Tom presented new ideas for additional equipment for the Imagination Station areas to replace some damaged or worn out areas. These ideas can be implemented in this year and next year's budget.
