

August 17, 2009 Minutes of Leo-Cedarville Park Board

Minutes of August 2 meeting approved as amended

Cindy reported on Schnelker Engineering receiving bids for the restroom at Riverside Gardens (RSG). These will be reviewed by the town council and the decision to accept bids will follow. Cindy updated the board about new current rental requests for L C pavilion and for events at Riverside Gardens.

Deana reported she is displaying the names of VIP's (volunteers in the parks) for the second quarter. She will utilize the Bulletin Board at LC Pavilion.

L-C Park

There have been vandals again at L-C Park. The Park Board is pursuing deterrents for vandalism which will include park surveillance

Follow-up on the pre IDEM inspection report. Any deficiencies will be corrected.

Marggie will be purchasing mums for the beds at L-C and RSG for fall floral color.

Marggie will be taking soil samples to Purdue Extension for soil testing to see if plants can be replaced at the circle drive at the LC pavilion.

Imagination Station upgrades, repairs and replacements are in process. Tom is working on the repairs. A new item of play equipment at Imagination Station is in place. A new mulch pad is to be placed soon under the test swing. Board discussed new equipment and ideas for enhancements for Imagination Station for next spring.

Tom and Cindy will attend the IPRA Seminar on trails in September.

Deana reported on Fall Festival, October 16, 2009. She is hoping for good volunteer involvement. Committees are forming at this time.

Cindy shared information about Indiana Community Tree Stewardship Program certification to be held on September 12 and 19, 2009.

Riverside Gardens

Jason Jura discussed his quote for rope lighting and seasonal lighting with board members. He was questioned as to whether we could add the lighting in stages to fit into our budget. Motion proposed that if financing is available Park Board is in favor of purchasing seasonal white rope lighting for Riverside Gardens pavilions. Tom motioned. Marggie seconded. Motion passed 3 - 1.

Board discussed Resolution in progress regarding volunteers in the park. Discussion tabled until future meeting.
