

June 16, 2008 Park Board Minutes

In attendance: Cindy Kimm, Deana Wright, Tom Kurtz, Peg Garton, Marggie Faley

Minutes of June 2, 2008 meeting were approved as distributed.

The board discussed the Budget and development of next year's budget.

Buildings and Grounds:

Peg reported on the clean up at the parks after recent storms. Many trees were damaged and some new trees will need to be staked. She described tasks the maintenance department is currently completing. Maintenance will be busy with preparation of the parks for Fourth of July activities.

It was noted that one of the 4 spruce trees that was to be moved at L-C Park is directly over an underground utility line.

Activities:

"By Kids for Kids" Sale was held as a first annual event last Thursday. Board discussed how to build up this event in the future

Landscape Committee:

Marggie distributed a list of committee work in progress. More plantings are planned for RSG. The committee is busy with weeding and watering.

Discussion:

Board discussed barrels donated by RAAB Water Conditioning for water at RSG. Board discussed water needs in 2 locations for watering. The barrels can be used when filled from the town water tank. Board agrees the water tank needs to be placed at RSG for ease of use. Cindy and Tom will secure the tank at RSG.

Cindy discussed electric work progress for the Grand Gazebo and working with our engineer on this. In addition, it is noted that the first shipment of the building parts will arrive on June 17th at the park.

A donation of \$1000 from Cedar Creek woman's Club will be partially used for a message board on the north side of the building at L-C Park. Deana is exploring designs for this sign. She will report at the next meeting.

Tom discussed work on Imagination Station at L-C Park including repairs and additions to equipment. He discussed ideas for improving playground area. Cindy proposed hiring a high school park maintenance intern for part time work. Motion seconded by Marggie. Cindy will explore this feasibility.
