

September 8, 2008 Leo-Cedarville Park Board Meeting

Members present: Tom Kurtz, Deana Wright, Cindy Kimm, Peg Garten, Marggie Faley

Meeting called to order at 1:02PM by Cindy Kimm.

Minutes of August 18, 2008 Meeting were approved as distributed.

Finance: Budget was distributed. Board to review.

Tom motioned and Deana seconded agreement to pay the final bill for completion of the Grand Gazebo in Riverside Gardens. Motion passed.

Maintenance

LC Park Pavilion maintenance: Peg reported on the needs and completed work on the pavilion door with estimates for replacements and repair. Tom will follow up on the proposed repair work. Inspection of the pavilion for mold is needed. Maintenance will complete inspection. Parking bolsters are completed for the parking areas. A cover was placed over the thermostat in the LC pavilion.

Electrical diagram is completed in the park in preparation for moving the flag pole. The electrical diagram will facilitate moving the Spruce Trees.

The board will begin pruning at LC Park. Board discussed the plan for pruning to best fit the goals of the park.

Rentals for the pavilion this fall include a Girl Scout Troop for monthly meetings during school year.

Riverside Gardens

Grand Gazebo installation will begin on September 29.

The board discussed a tentative landscaping hardscape around the major drain pipe. Flag stone will be used as a splash path to disperse run off. Ground cover will be planted for erosion control.

Tom distributed an electrical plan for the Grand Gazebo. Board discussed the plan.

Fall Festival: Deana discussed preparations. Date is Saturday, October 18, (Rain Date, Friday, October 24). Time 5:30 - 7:30PM. Deana shared the hard work of her committee; developing a volunteer list, obtaining sponsors and exploring new games and activities for the Festival.

Landscaping

Fine pruning bushes at Leo-Cedarville Park will start this week.

Cindy proposed hiring the arborist to inspect the trees at LC Park. Marggie motioned to hire the arborist, Tom seconded. Motion passed.

The board discussed the Leo High School Community Service Activity on September 18. The board devised a plan for jobs for the students for the morning in both parks and at the boat landing stations.
