

June 7, 2010 Park Board Minutes

In attendance: Cindy Kimm, Tom Kurtz, Marggie Faley

Minutes of May 17 meeting were approved as printed.

Budget: Vouchers were reviewed and approved by Board.

Maintenance: Riverside Gardens

Recent rentals went well at RSG and cleanup was adequate. We will hold all rentals responsible for appropriate cleanup after their event. Vandals stole the motor off our water tank at Riverside Gardens. We are disappointed by this rude behavior and will prosecute the vandals. Mulching of paths at RSG is nearing completion. Our first concert in the park will be June 11. Tom will secure one leaning tree in the beds at RSG near the Grand Gazebo. Cindy shared estimates from vendors for water softener for the Restroom at RSG. Board will review and discuss at the next meeting.

Cindy shared the letter from Park Board with donation for Leo-Cedarville Chamber of Commerce 4th of July Celebration.

Maintenance: Leo-Cedarville Park:

Board discussed Playground Equipment and ground maintenance at Leo-Cedarville Park. We will again contract with a professional firm to clean and seal Imagination Station, closing the IS for the week of June 28. Temporary workers will be starting various jobs at the park next week. Board will devise a schedule for the temporary workers and post it for them.

Tom shared his research into materials for plaques for recognition of past Park Board advisory and committee members' contributions. He will continue to work on this. Board discussed plaques for marking trails in RSG which is part of our Master Plan for the parks.

Marggie discussed the success of our first day of the Farmers' Market. Nearly 200 customers shopped at the market. Thank you Leo-Cedarville community for supporting our farmers' market. Few issues surfaced on the first day. Board discussed the issue of weather. Vendors are encouraged to have protection for rain. We will open overflow parking across the street in future markets. Marggie shared her ideas for continuing advertising for the farmers' market.

Cindy is working on reorganizing the Park Board file cabinet.
