

May 17, 2010 Leo-Cedarville Park board Meeting

In attendance: Cindy Kimm, Tom Kurtz, Marggie Faley
Minutes of May 3, Meeting were approved as amended

Budget: Vouchers were presented for signing. Board discussed expenditures. Particular items will be explained next meeting.

Maintenance:

Riverside Gardens: Fence for dumpster is completed near restrooms; dumpster door will have wheels. Finishing mulch will be placed at trees. Horse hitches are in place. Cindy will test power washing of pavilions with existing equipment.

Leo-Cedarville Park: Arrow fence completed most of work, Cindy to follow up with them for final work at N. E. corner of park. Mulching is to be completed soon to L-C Park. Tom shared that Imagination Station will be closed June 28 through July 2 for cleaning and sealing of IS play equipment.

Buildings and Grounds:

Riverside Gardens: Restroom facility has a tool organizer in maintenance room thanks to Tom. Girl Scouts planted beds near the restrooms on Sat. May 15 and helped with general work on beds. Thanks to Marva Thompson and her assistant for their work with the Girl Scouts on this project. Mulch is in the park for finishing of path. Weeding is ongoing with temporary workers taking care of this. N. E. corner sign bed is replanted; donated plants added. Thanks to Amy Mohr for her generous donations. Rental Flyer boxes are installed.

L-C: Flyer box installed. Tom will advise through signage and roping off where he will be working on IS. Cindy is exploring IS Fountain pressure regulation. A recent rental left L-C pavilion failing to clean up appropriately after their rental. Board discussed how to proceed with the renter not following rental procedures.

Resolution 2010-02 -Farmers' Market. Motion presented by Tom to forgo re-reading the Resolution at this time. Marggie seconded. Motion made for adoption of the Resolution 2010-02 by Tom, seconded by Marggie. Motion passed.

Farmers' Market: Board discussed promotion. Marggie shared her promotion activities in the media and around the area. Board discussed preparations for Farmers' Market opening day. Banners will be placed, final promotion will be complete. Farmers' Market opening will have balloons released. Final clean up and pavilion preparation was discussed. Tasks to be done were addressed. Opening will be 3:00PM, Tuesday, June 1, 2010.

Board discussed sponsorship of a band for the 4th of July Fireworks event. Tom motioned to have Board grant a set amount for sponsorship of a music group for the 4th of July event. Marggie Seconded. Motion passed.
