

May 3, 2010 Leo-Cedarville Park Board Minutes

In attendance: Cindy Kimm, Tom Kurtz, Marggie Faley

Minutes of April 19, 2010 approved as distributed.

Budget: Vouchers were discussed. New items and the remainder of the Spring expenses were discussed. Discussed final expense column on last years budget for comparison and prediction for expenses this year.

Maintenance: Water tank will be moved to Riverside Gardens at top of hill behind a fence for use for watering beds there. Compost as fertilizer will be broadcast as soon as it is drier; RSG areas have been aerated. Deep edging of planting beds is progressing. Mulching at RSG is almost complete with the generous help of volunteers last weekend. Need more mulch to completely cover the paths.

Building and Grounds

Riverside Gardens: Restroom facility shelving is to be covered. Cindy spoke with engineer about exposed pipes outside north side of restrooms. NE corner sign bed cleaned this week, new plantings in place and more plant donations expected there.

L-C Park: Bushes and beds cleaning and pruning started along Washington St. Flyer box will be placed on pavilion at ADA required height. Tom distributed pictures of his plans for mulching Imagination Station. Tom reported on improvements needed. We will begin to construct new additions to IS. Tom shared costs for new chimes for Tot Area. Marggie moved that we accept Tom's quote for purchasing new chimes, Tom seconded. Motion passed.

Fountain is up and turned on; maintenance staff will adjust it for efficiency. Duct cleaning of pavilion is completed. Fence repair will be completed soon.

Committees: Board discussed participation in L-C Chambers of Commerce 4th of July celebration. Park Board will sponsor an event at the Celebration. Board discussed park events and our budget for this year. Some changes may be made due to resources available this year.

Resolution 2001-02 Farmers' Market: Marggie shared the Resolution with the board. Discussion ensued; suggestions will be incorporated into the Resolution and presented to board members.

Farmers' Market: Marggie shared some promotion ideas with the Board. Board discussed estimate for banners to advertise the Farmer's Market. Marggie will follow up. Currently 10 seasonal vendors are signed up with a booth each Tuesday evening 3:00PM to 700PM. We have 2 vendors interested in occasional booths throughout the summer.

Board discussed preparing a list of options for donations to the parks with specific items that donor can purchase.
